

Tournament Credit & Refund Policy (Non-YMS Tournaments)

TOURNAMENT CREDITS

In the event that a tournament is cancelled, either partially or fully, and a team receives a CREDIT, teams must follow this process:

- 1. The team must notify the YMS administrator of the cancellation, and whether a credit will exist for your team.
- 2. All credit rules and policies for the individual tournament will apply.
 - a. If the credit can be applied to a different tournament in the series, the team must make every effort to use the credit in the current year. Example: EDP tournament that gets cancelled in the fall.
 - i. The team should apply the credit to a different EDP event in the spring.
 - b. If the credit can be applied to a different tournament in the series, and the team cannot use it in the current year, it may be used the following year. Example: An EDP tournament gets canceled in the spring, and another EDP event will not fit into the schedule.
 - The team must receive approval to carry over their event credit to a different EDP event the following year. If approved, they will receive the equal value of that credit the following year.
 - c. If a credit is given for that specific tournament the following year, the team must participate in that tournament the following year to earn the credit. Example: Jeff Cup issues a credit for a rain out.
 - i. The team must attend Jeff Cup the following year, in order for the team to use the credit.
 - ii. Once the team uses their event credit, YMS will issue a monetary credit to the team (less any fees kept by the tournament) that they may apply to an additional tournament outside of YMS One. The team will be responsible for the balance of the additional tournament fees not covered by the credit.
- 3. If a team chooses to replace a canceled event in the current year, and the replacement exceeds the number of tournaments allotted by YMS One, the team will be responsible for the cost of the replacement tournament.
- 4. No refunds will be issued by YMS for any unused tournament credits.

TOURNAMENT REFUNDS

In the event that a tournament is cancelled, either partially or fully, and a team receives a REFUND from the event, teams must follow this process:

- 1. The team must notify the YMS administrator of the cancellation, and whether a refund will exist for your team.
- 2. All refund rules and policies for the individual tournament will apply.
 - a. If the event is fully canceled and a full refund is received (less any administrative costs), the team can replace the cancelled tournament with another event in the current year.
 - b. If the event is partially cancelled and a partial refund is received, YMS will issue that monetary credit to the team that they may apply to an additional tournament outside of YMS One. The team will be responsible for the balance of those additional tournament fees not covered by the refund.
- 3. No refunds will be issued by YMS for any unused tournament refunds.
